On September 2015, The Foundation for the Protection and Promotion of Justice provided 30 wheelchairs to the Centro del Estudio de la Cultura Budista Oriental in Asuncion, Paraguay, whose doors are open to all, but pays particular attention to those within the community who are less fortunate.

The recipients of these wheelchairs suffer from a broad range of disabilities. Lacking personal mobility, they are confined to their homes and unable to live a full and inclusive life.

Isolated from their community, they are more likely to develop secondary complications and become more disabled and poorer still.

A gift of a wheelchair can change a life. Independent mobility makes it possible for people to study, work, participate in cultural life and access health care.
